**Amarjit Singh Chandhiok** is a Senior Advocate practicing in the Supreme Court and High Courts in India.

He is former Additional Solicitor General of India and former Principal Counsel, European Union Commission. He was President of the Delhi High Court Bar Association six times. Currently he is the President Elect of the Bar Association of India, President of INSOL India and Council for Conflict Resolution – Maadhyam.

Apart from being an expert on civil laws, Amarjit is also recognized as a leading insolvency lawyer apart from being an expert in mediation and arbitration.

Amarjit was instrumental in creating and implementing many policies and projects for the benefit of the Bar. He advocated the necessity of creating a legislative sanction in this regard and thus, the Advocates' Welfare Fund Act, 2001 came into being. He played a vital role in creating various infrastructure facilities for members of the Bar in Delhi.
