Ms. Krishna Sarma is the Managing Partner of Corporate Law Group (CLG), a New Delhi based Indian law firm. She joined the Bar in Delhi in 1993. She has a Bachelor's degree in law from University of Delhi. Krishna has a significant life sciences and bio-pharmaceuticals practice – she sits on the Company Boards of Biogen Idec India, DIA and Mango Sciences.

Krishna was Additional Advocate General for the State of Assam in the Supreme Court of India from 2011 till 2016 and her firm was Standing Counsels from 2001-2016.

Krishna is committed to a number of social causes. She led an initiative on Assam Floods which came out with a scientific report and recommendations that fed into the Government of India's Report in 2018. She authored a Legal White Paper on the National Register of Citizens in June, 2018. Krishna is also deeply interested in Textiles and History, focused at supporting women weavers, particularly of her home state of Assam and authored an Illustrated History Book: "Assam a journey through its Textiles" in 2019.
