

Shri Mohan Parasaran **Senior Advocate**

Mohan Parasaran is a Senior Advocate at the Supreme Court of India. In February 2013 he was appointed the Solicitor General of India and continued in this post till May 2014. He served as part of the Congress led UPA 2 government.^[1] Previously he held the post of Additional Solicitor General of India for nine years.^[2] In 2012, he resigned from the post of Additional Solicitor General but the resignation was not accepted by the Government.^[3] He was designated senior advocate in 2002.

Parasaran has received the B.A. (Economics) First Class from the University of Madras in 1981, a Bachelor of Law degree from Faculty of Law, University of Delhi in 1984 and a Master of Laws from the University of Cambridge.
