BA (L) LLB, Sriranga Subbanna began his legal career in the year 1993 when he started as an Apprentice at Sundaraswamy Ramdas and Anand (SRA). A brief introduction. A 2nd generation lawyer who joined the Chamber's of M/s Sundaraswamy, Ramdas and Anand as an Apprentice in the year 1993 and upon graduation in the year 1996 continued as an Apprentice under the then existing Rules of compulsory apprenticeship of 1 year and enrolled as an advocate in Karnataka State Bar Council in the year 1997.

Having worked as an Associate of M/s Sundaraswamy, Ramdas and Anand and appeared in a wide variety of matters before City Civil Court, Debt Recovery Tribunal, Consumer Forums, Customs, Excise and Service Tax Appellate Tribunal (CESTAT), Income Tax Appellate Tribunal (ITAT), Appellate Authority under Air and Water Act, Company Law Boards, High Courts in India and Supreme Court of India.

With the bifurcation of the said firm, he continued to work as Partner of M/s JUSTLAW from the year 2008 till date. He has conducted domestic and international arbitrations on behalf of entities in the Electricity Sector, Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation Ltd. (BMRCL), real estate companies and other State and Central public sector undertakings such as BEML, KAVIKA etc.

He has represented the transmission and electricity distribution utilities of the State of Karnataka and has been actively involved in advisory work pertaining to regulatory aspects of the electricity sector. He has appeared regularly before various regulatory forums and also the Appellate Tribunal for Electricity, representing the state sector. He has also been engaged as a Special Counsel by the Government of Karnataka in electricity related matters.

He has also representing the Bar Council of India, Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority (IRDA), Institute Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI), Industrial Financial Corporation of India (IFCI) and other State and Central Government owned Banks before the High Court of Karnataka. In addition, he has represented the High Court Administration and Administration of City Civil Court including advisory work and is an active Member of Advocates Association of Bangalore (High Court Unit) and Supreme Court Bar Association. Has been a member and continues to be a member of the Governing Council of the Bar

Association of India, New Delhi. Member of the Law Society ,UK. Member of Law Asia and Fellow of Indian Council of Arbitration.
